Year Round School

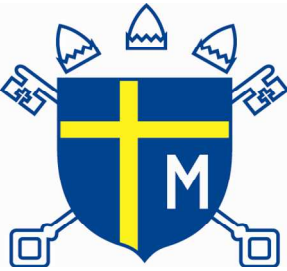
Do you get bored in the summer? Do you like active living? Would you like to gather with your friends in August?
